An overview of the financial records for the Kansas Association of School Business Officials (KASBO) for the fiscal year ending June 30th, 2019 was conducted on November 10th, 2020.


The expenditures totaling \$250,123.62 were reconciled to the bank statements, check register and Treasurer's report. Disbursements were reviewed for supporting documentation, approvals, and authorized signatures.

The receipts totaling \$249,852.94 were reconciled to the bank statements, Treasurer's report, and traced to supporting documentation.

The June 30<sup>th</sup>, 2019 checking account balance of \$83,862.54 and the savings account balance of \$72,165.56 were both reconciled to the respective bank statements and accounting records. There are also two CD's in the amount of \$50,000 and \$25,000 respectively.


2018 1099 filings and W-9's was reviewed and appear to be reasonable and accurate.
